

Donation Policy

NoteWorthy Singers (“Choir”)

Directed Donations

When the Choir receives a donation, the donor has the option to specify that their funds be allocated to a particular goal or project. The Choir will make every effort to honour such requests. If it is not possible to accommodate the donor’s wishes, the Treasurer will communicate this to the donor, provide an explanation, and suggest an alternative use for the donation. In cases where no specific direction is provided by the donor, all donations will be added to the Choir’s general fund.

Acknowledgement of Donations

Donations made specifically towards the purchase of music will be recognized by a notation at the bottom of the music piece that has been purchased with those funds. If the donor prefers to remain anonymous, their wishes will be respected and either a notation will be placed on the music that the donation was made anonymously, or no acknowledgement will be made on the music.

Use of Donations for Music Purchases

The Choir will make every reasonable effort to ensure that any donation intended for the purchase of music is used to acquire music that will be performed during the next Choir term. The Music Director will provide a potential donor with music pieces that the Music Director has determined will be purchased and the donor will advise which if any piece they wish to donate towards.

After a potential donor advises that they wish to donate towards a particular piece of music, the Treasurer will contact the donor and advise the final cost and arrange for receipt of monies from the donor. After monies are received, the Treasurer will advise the Music Director that payment has been received and advise the Chair of the Music Library Committee to place a notation on the purchased piece of music.

Reporting and Public Recognition

All donations received will be acknowledged by the Board Chair, who will send a letter or card to the donor indicating how the funds were applied. In addition, donations may be publicly recognized by announcement from either the Board Chair or the Music Director at Choir rehearsals or luncheons, unless the donor has requested anonymity. As the Choir is not a registered charity donations are not tax-deductible.
