

Privacy Policy

NoteWorthy Singers (“Choir”)

The Choir is committed to protecting the privacy of personal information. We regard the privacy of our members' personal information with the utmost respect. The contact details provided by Choir members are used exclusively for communication regarding musical activities and choir-related matters. Oversight of this privacy policy, including any necessary amendments, rests with the Choir Board of Directors (“Board”).

Use of Contact Information

We collect and use Choir members' contact information to send updates about Choir activities and musical events happening in our community. Should any member prefer not to receive these informational emails, they are welcome to notify us at any time. This can be done simply by replying to our notices and expressing a preference to opt out. Upon receiving such a request, we will promptly update our mailing list to respect the member's wishes.

Sharing Information

We do not share, sell, lend, or lease information that uniquely identifies our website or individual Choir members. Any requests for announcements or emails related to events not directly connected to choir business must be reviewed by the Executive Committee. If the Executive Committee is uncertain about whether an announcement should be made, the request should be referred to the Board Chair for a decision.

Your Consent and Data Security

We are committed to maintaining the security of your data. Please note that all information is stored on our computer systems in Canada. We have implemented appropriate procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

Public Performances and Video Sharing

When a choir performs in a public setting, it is common for performances to be recorded or photographed. These recordings serve as valuable learning tools for all musicians and will be shared online, either by the Choir executive, Choir members, or audience members who attend our events. It will be shared on platforms including, but not limited to, YouTube and Facebook. Other distribution platforms may be used such as peer-to-peer email. In addition, group and candid photos may be used for promotional purposes, such as posters, flyers, and newspaper articles. Individual Choir members will not be personally tagged in these recordings or images, meaning they will not be identifiable through online searches about specific individuals. If you would prefer not to be photographed in close-up images, please inform the Board Chair. We will make every effort to accommodate your request.
